Thank you for your 227.27 donation on 3/22/13 to the Serve Veterans Fund, a public charity organized and operated for the purpose to serve Veterans of the US Armed Forces and their families in need, with spiritual, mental, physical, and financial assistance. The Serve Veterans Fund is an organization exempt from Federal income tax under section 501c3 of the Internal Revenue Code. Contributions made to the Serve Veterans Fund are deductible under section 170 of the Code. Enclosed is a IRS letter assuring you that your donation will be deductible as a charitable contribution on your federal income tax. The Serve Veterans Fund did not provide any substantial goods or services for this donation. Please keep this for your tax records.

Since this is a newly created Fund, in its early years of existence, we will use your generous donation to enable this organization to continue its charitable activities and expand it's public solicitation and public relations program.

As a nonprofit public charity, the Serve Veterans Fund must receive most of its support of grants, gifts, contributions from governmental units, other public charities, foundations, and from the general public. So the Serve Veterans Fund is using the contributions received this year for the activity to design and build a program for public solicitation of funds. A majority of the residents of the United States are unaware of this charitable funds existence. So the Serve Veterans Fund is also using the contributions received this year for the activity to design and build a program for public relations, public education and awareness.

As a nonprofit charitable fund, we operate for purposes that are beneficial to the public interest, such as relief of the poor, the distressed, or the underprivileged. From 12/05 to the present, the Fund has assisted 8 Veterans, 3 widows of Veterans, and one son of a veteran in our community. We have helped with companionship, housing, moving, transportation, grocery shopping, paying bills, security, and family business matters. Unfortunately we have had a delay assembling our first metal building upon the Serve Veterans Fund land, but as soon as the construction project is completed, we will then be able to assist more Veterans in need directly at our headquarters. Our goal is to provide shelter for the homeless. According to the National Alliance to End Homelessness (NAEH) between 700,000 to 800,000 people are homeless on any night in the United States, with between 2.5 and 3.5 million people experiencing homelessness during the course of a year. According to a nationwide HUD study called Continuum of Care, 19-23% of the total homeless population nationwide are Veterans. There are 24.9 million military Veterans in the United States. The Serve Veterans Fund is all about assisting Veterans in need of an emergency shelter or of a transitional place to live.
